

## APUSH SUMMER READING ASSIGNMENT

1. Read Period 1: 1491-1607 section of your textbook (pages 2-36). This Period is broken into 4 separate sections/modules.
2. Take Cornell notes for each Module of the section (4 total sets of notes).
3. Complete *AP Writing Historically: Responding to a Short-Answer Question Using ACE* activity on pages 21-23. Read through activity and then complete question 2 on pg. 23.
4. Complete *AP Writing Historically: Using Categories to Respond to a Short-Answer Question* on pages 28-29. Read through the activity and then complete the SAQ at the bottom of page 29.
5. Complete *AP Analyzing Sources* on page 35. Answer all 3 questions in complete sentences.

All notes must be **written by hand** in a spiral notebook that will be used **exclusively** for APUSH notes and will be checked for completion on the first day of class.

Items 3, 4 and 5 above may be typed and submitted electronically by the first day of class.

***There will be a test on Period 1 the first week of school. This test will be multiple choice. If you read the modules and take notes you should be prepared for this test. There is a review of period 1 on page 39 that may also help you prepare. All test questions in APUSH come directly from the College Board and are college level.***
